In October 2017 Year 3 led our Harvest Assembly. All of the children in the school also contributed by making a harvest box. The boxes were offered during the assembly and then the Chaplaincy Team with Year 3 took them to Our Lady of Compassion Church. During a short service led by Fr. David the boxes were handed over to the SVP for distribution to the elderly of the parish as well as Jimmy's Night Shelter in Cambridge.
